July 2024 Activity Report

- Did 83 locates
- Spent several days hauling off brush at the drop off site
- Dug out and rocked the old flower beds at Hwy22 and Howard Burton
- Added rock and smoothed up several alleys and shoulders
- Attended weekly dept. head meetings
- Attended city council meeting
- Met with a contractor about sidewalk replacement
- Patched potholes
- Called out 7/9/24 to move tree limb that was blocking the road
- Met with Matt and looked at road and driveway for possible street creep
- Replaced post and put no parking on North St. back up that was run over
- Started inventorying the city's signs and comparing to the ordinances to see if what is out there is correct
- Equipment maintenance:
 - Cleaned work trucks, and loader
 - Replaced strobe light on backhoe
 - Replaced strobe light and work lights on grader
- Drainage work:
 - Spent several days working on drainage
 - Shot grade on several ditches
 - Added 20ft of 10in metal culvert to widen driveway at 715 Ivy Lane for the homeowner
 - Cleaned ditch on Rodemyre, Bradford
 - Installed storm sewer on Southgate for Brice Gibling:
 - set 160ft of 18in plastic pipe, 2 tees, built 1 storm inlet, and connected several gutter drains, and hauled in dirt to smooth up and cleaned up area
 - Installed storm sewer on Southgate b/w Jefferson and Jenkins:
 - Set 65ft of 24in plastic pipe, 1 tee, and hauled in dirt to cover up
 - Borrowed vac truck and flushed several culverts
