# Minutes:

Hydrant flushing is on track to be completed by May 5th. Marty met with Gary Brons of McClure Engineering about providing a quote to create a hydraulic modeling plan for the water treatment and distribution system. What this modeling would provide is information on water quality, age of the water, potential areas of concern, etc., relating to the water system based on what water treatment plants are running and at what times. Along with providing crucial information about our current system, this program allows for future planning based on the City's comprehensive plan for planning and zoning providing information on recommended water main size, best location for futuristic water treatment plants and information relating to pressure zones to mention a few. The Water Department will begin working with a company, BSI Online, that will provide assistance in tracking the testing of customer backflow devices that are required by the state of Iowa. Hiawatha's Annual Earth Day Event is April 22nd at the maintenance shop on Robins Rd from 9:00am to 10:30 am. This is open to all Hiawatha residents to discard items such as electronics, flags, glasses, prescription medication and shred documents.
