WHEREAS, the City of Rock Springs has entered into an agreement with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Wyoming, to provide medical insurance administrative services; and,

WHEREAS, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Wyoming has submitted ASO Group Plan Changes to said medical insurance, which plan changes are to become effective on March 1, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of said City has said ASO Group Plan Changes, before it and has given them careful review and consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, STATE OF WYOMING:

Changes: The City would like to implement a new anniversary date beginning 1/1/21, and plan year 1/1/21-12/31/21. The City will be implementing a choice plan as of 1/1/21 with up to three plan options for its Members. They will need all Admin and Stop Loss renewal information by the middle of October going forward.

Plan Changes:

1. Eliminate the Deductible Carry Forward provision.
2. Eliminate the Supplemental Accident Rider.
3. Eliminate the \$1,000 maximum on ground ambulance.
4. Increase Office Co-Pay from \$20 to \$30 and eliminate the "After which Covered Services will be provided at 100% of the Allowable Charge without reference to the Deductible or Coinsurance up to \$200."
5. Implement a \$50 Urgent Care Co-Pay (not Emergency Room).
6. Implement any required PPACA preventive changes.
7. Update the Rx benefit structure to:
 - Retail (30-day supply)
 - Generic: \$10 Co-Pay
 - Preferred Brand: \$25 Co-Pay
 - Non-Preferred Brand: \$50 Co-Pay
 - Specialty: 20% Coinsurance
 - Mail Order (90-day supply)
 - Generic: \$20 Co-Pay
 - Preferred Brand: \$25 Co-Pay
 - Non-Preferred Brand: \$50 Co-Pay
 - Specialty: 20% Coinsurance

8. Increase the Total-In-Network OOP Maximum in accordance with PPACA (\$8,150/\$16,300)
