KAUMO, AS MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, AND MATTHEW L. MCBURNETT, AS CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, WYOMING, TO EXECUTE SAID AMENDED CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, a Fireworks Production Contract between the City of Rock Springs and Fireworks West Internationale, Inc., for a fireworks production to be held on July 4, 2019, was accepted and approved by the Governing Body on March 19, 2019, by Resolution 2019-37; and,

WHEREAS, Fireworks West Internationale, Inc., has submitted to the City of Rock Springs, Wyoming, an amended Fireworks Production Contract to amend the amount of liability insurance offered by Fireworks West Internationale, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Rock Springs has reviewed said amended contract, and has given it careful review and consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROCK SPRINGS, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That the terms and provisions of the Amended Fireworks Production Contract with Fireworks West Internationale, Inc., attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby accepted and approved by the City of Rock Springs, Wyoming.

That the Mayor of the City be, and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said amended contract on behalf of the City of Rock Springs, Wyoming; and that the City Clerk of said City, be and he is hereby, authorized and directed to attach to said amended contract a certified copy of this Resolution.

Attached is an updated agreement with Fireworks West Internationale, Inc., the company who we contracted with a couple months ago for our fireworks show on July 4, 20019.

I was informed that when they went to acquire the liability insurance in the amount offered in the original agreement it would cost nearly half of what the total value of the contract (fireworks show) is. Apparently there are only four sources for this type of liability coverage and these costs have skyrocketed.

With that, the only amendment to the contract is the amount of liability insurance offered by Fireworks West Internationale, Inc. I have spoken to our city attorney about this change and he confirms that the one-million dollar liability policy now being offered will meet the city requirements.
