About the Trail

The ever-evolving Sheldon Recreational Trail now circles about two-thirds of the community. Interesting features along the 7.23-mile paved pathway include the Sheldon School District and Village Northwest Unlimited campuses; Hills Park recreation area, where a trail head archway is located; a corridor of trees and a wooded area; a rest area near the Floyd River; a native prairie reconstruction area near Northwest Iowa Community College and a stretch running along the river.
